The new (HBN) 00-10, Part C standards includes additional information about sustainability and infection control, specifying that all new build healthcare facilities should achieve an 'excellent' rating and all refurbishments achieve a 'very good' rating under BREEAM.



The specification was exacting to ensure a long, efficient product life and savings in water and energy use. Products from Franke Washroom Systems have included; an array of differing formats of HTM63 stainless steel sinks and worktops, disposal and janitorial units.





SINKS WITH DRAINERS

Our clinical sinks fall in line with the Department for Health recommendation of the sinks that can be used in hospital applications with the following types available:

- ST A Single bowl, single drainer
- ST B Single bowl, double drainer
- ST C Double bowl, single drainer

Manufactured from 1.2 mm thick, grade 304 stainless steel with a satin polish finish, the sink tops are turned down on all four edges and incorporate a wet area recess. To prevent the harbour of dirt, germs and bacteria, all models are without overflow. The bowls are prepared for a 38mm waste outlet and we can supply a flush grated waste as an extra. Stainless steel wall brackets or front leg supports can also be supplied where additional support is required.

Sinks are available with tapholes at 200mm centres, or without tapholes.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Department of Health within their (HBN) 00-10, Part C guidelines that sinks used in clinical areas such as dirty utility areas should not have tapholes or overflows, therefore wall mounted taps should be used.





SINKS

Commonly known in the industry as SK 1 (single bowl) and SK 2 (double bowl) sinks, our expertly manufactured models have been designed in accordance with the HTM 64 specification. Manufactured from 1.2 thick, grade 304 stainless steel and with a satin polish finish, the bowls have been prepared for a 38mm waste outlet and come without an overflow. The sink top is turned down on all four edges and incorporates a wet recess area to ensure that any splashes remain inside the bowl.

Sinks are available without tapholes or with tapholes at 200mm centres.

PLASTER SINK

Plaster sinks are used in areas where casting materials are prepared. Designed in accordance with the HTM 64 standard, our PS H plaster sink is manufactured from 1.2mm thick, grade 304 stainless steel with 1.5mm thick for the bowl. The single bowl incorporates a lift out plaster catcher basket which is prepared for a 38mm waste and is supplied with a lid to prevent loose plaster from entering the waste and causing a blockage. It also comes without tapholes or overflow.

A choice of either stainless steel cantilever brackets or front leg supports are supplied separately, one of which will be required to support it.

ATM63 SINKS

We have a full range of HTM 63 sit on sinks with a radiused front edge together with a radiused internal corner at the base of the upstand. Sink bowls are prepared for a 38mm waste outlet and the units are available in 1000mm, 1200mm, 1500mm and 1800mm lengths. All are available either with or without tapholes at 200mm centres.

CLEANING AND JANITORIAL

Franke provide a comprehensive range of cleaning and janitorial products, which will help with the daily cleaning activities within hospitals and healthcare facilities. One of our most popular products is our janitorial unit which is ideal for where space restricts the installation of a separate sink and wash-hand basin.

Our janitorial unit designed to HTM 64 specification with copper tails and a lever operated monobloc mixer tap is made with 1.2mm thick, grade 304 stainless steel and 0.9mm thick for the lower bowl. Supplied with both a 32mm flush grated waste for the top wash bowl and 38mm domed waste outlet for the lower bowl it can be floor standing with all 4 legs or made partly wall hung by just using the front 2 legs and the joggle strip provided.

The unit has a large bottom drainage to allow for a large volume of water and we can even supply a complementing stainless steel bucket if required.


